How was the lesson instructed?

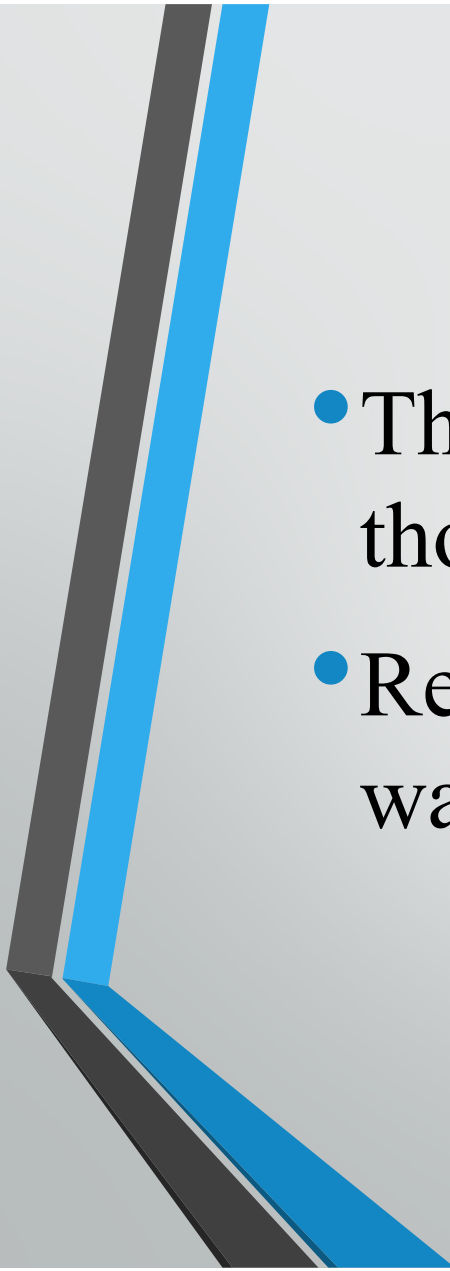
The task topics given to the students were carefully selected.

- The officer in the disabled unit said that, the lower branches of the trees in the campus area were cut at the request of the blind students.

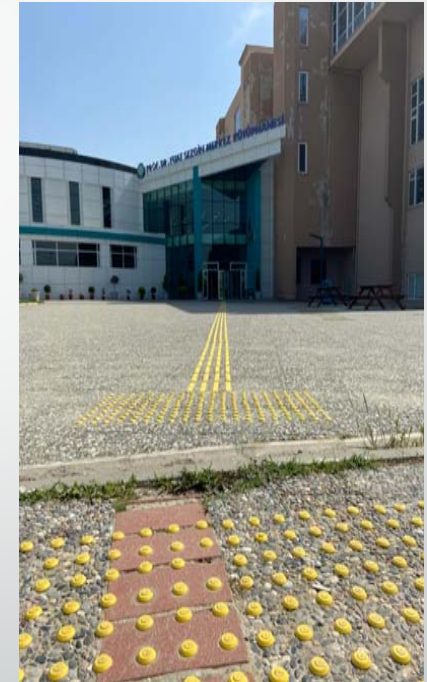
- The disabled unit helps students to access their course materials.
- The disability unit establishes a connection between students and academic staff.
- For students with disabilities, enlargement of the font size or additional time is required.

- The disability unit helps students with disabilities to be placed in dormitories.
- The disability unit creates opportunities for students with disabilities to participate in arts, sports and cultural activities.
- The disabled unit cooperates with different institutions and organizations with special projects.
- Disable unit helps students meet with employers and get employment.
